- **Beat The Street Community Center, Inc., Meriden, CT** - Beat The Street Community Center's (BTS) mission is to make a profound, positive difference in the lives of young people whose circumstances put them at risk of falling far short of their true potential. BTS has its own Community Garden.
- **Covenant to Care for Children, Hartford, CT** – Covenant to Care for Children channels the generosity of caring and faithful people to advocate for, and provide direct assistance to Connecticut's children who are neglected, abused and/or impoverished.
- **Friendly Hands Food Bank, Inc., Torrington, CT** – The Friendly Hands Food Bank, Inc., is a Nonprofit Organization located in Willimantic at St. Paul's Church that addresses the local problem of urban poverty and food insecurity.
- **Hillside Food Outreach, Danbury, CT** – Hillside Food Outreach exists to provide food to people who are, for whatever reason, unable to access local food pantries. They also provide food bags for special needs diets, such as diabetes.
- **Holy Family Home and Shelter, Inc., Willimantic, CT** – Holy Family Home and Shelter, Inc., is a home and shelter for mothers and children that provide three meals a day, life skills workshops, case management, laundry facilities, an education program for children, assistance with permanent housing and employment searches, and referrals to other agencies as needed.
- **Plainville Community Food Pantry, Plainville, CT** – Plainville Community Food Pantry (PCFP) provides food, clothing, emergency energy assistance, furniture and household items, crisis intervention and referral services to Plainville residents in need. PCFP offers holiday baskets at Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- **The Tiny Miracles Foundation, Darien, CT** – The Tiny Miracles Foundation provides compassionate and comprehensive services, programs, and support for premature babies and their families throughout Fairfield County. We work closely with and provide services to Bridgeport, Norwalk, Stamford, and Danbury Hospitals.
- **W.H.E.A.T. Food Pantry, West Haven, CT** – West Haven Emergency Assistance Taskforce (W.H.E.A.T) is a central place where West Haven residents in crisis can go for food.
